Job Summary: Under broad supervision, the Carpenter assists in coordinating the engineering, maintenance, renovation, and construction of facilities. Performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled building trades work in the repair, maintenance or construction of state buildings and related structures. Moves furniture or equipment within state buildings and facilities. May serve as a lead worker and/or supervise support staff. Position requires on-call availability. The Carpenter also performs other job-related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in a related field from an accredited college or university **AND** one (1) year of related experience; OR Four (4) years of related experience OR One (1) year of experience at the lower level Fac Maintenance Engineer 2 (FEP041) or position equivalent.

Preferred Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED **AND** four (4) years of experience in construction. **OR** One (1) year of experience at the lower level Fac Maintenance Engineer 2 (FEP041) or position equivalent.

Note: Must be able to meet the agency's requirements to be an authorized driver.

Competencies: General knowledge of moving furniture, equipment, and using the proper handling skills with moving equipment. Ability to read, interpret and apply construction plans, specifications, and blueprints. Ability to lift, push, pull and carry heavy items. Ability to lift to 50lbs.
