Position Description: Under general supervision, the Craftsman 3 performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled building trades work in the repair, maintenance or construction of state buildings and related structures. Installs and maintains modular furniture systems, climate control, and other facilities systems. May serve as lead worker and/or supervise support staff. The Craftsman 3 also performs other job-related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in a related field from an accredited college or university <u>AND</u> one (1) year of related experience; OR Four (4) years of related experience OR One (1) year of experience at the lower level Fac Maintenance Engineer 2 (FEP041) or position equivalent.

<u>Competencies</u>: Considerable knowledge of the methods of maintenance and repair; of skill and technical areas in such as welding, HVAC, carpentry, sheet metal fabrication, electricity, plumbing, etc.; of the use of relevant trade tools, equipment, and materials. General knowledge of building construction/repair with considerable skill in at least one trade relating to renovation/construction. Ability to read, interpret and apply construction plans, specifications, and blueprints. Working skill in diagnosing maintenance and repair problems. Some skill in supervising less skilled mechanics. Ability to lift, push, pull and carry heavy items
